Scope of Work

Olivewood's Sustainable Agriculture Apprenticeship is an opportunity to learn about organic gardening techniques as well as gain insight into the operations of a garden-based education program. The intern will work with the Director of Gardens and Facilities Manager and Garden Support Staff to assist with garden maintenance; including weeding, watering, harvesting, composting, and more. As an organization rooted in community, this role requires active participation in anti-racist work and a commitment to diversity and inclusion. The hourly rate is \$18/hour.

Garden and Grounds Maintenance Duties:

- Oversee and maintain an assigned garden area
- Assist with additional garden tasks outside of assigned area, to include watering, weeding, building compost, digging and clearing beds, planting, harvesting, and more

Qualifications

- The Ideal Candidate: Is community service minded, Enjoys working outside, Is a good communicator and takes direction well, Can think critically and problem solve, Has an appreciation for the garden and our mission, and Is eager to learn and have fun!
- Previous experience in gardening or working in an outdoor setting is preferred
- Spanish language proficiency is preferred



Physical Demands:

- Work is performed in an outdoor setting with a moderate noise level;

- While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to:
 - stand the whole day;
 - walk;
 - use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms;
 - climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl;
 - talk or hear and taste or smell.
